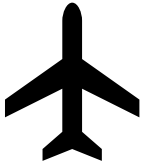


# GETTING TO (AND AROUND) SALT LAKE CITY!

## REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION: BUS & COMMUTER RAIL



### Utah Transit Authority (UTA) TRAX

Salt Lake City offers both bus and commuter rail services through the Utah Transit Authority ([UTA](#)) TRAX. If you are interested in exploring the area, the UTA TRAX offers FrontRunner (commuter rail) service between Ogden north of Salt Lake City all the way south to Provo. When using the public transportation, we suggest consulting with the [Plan Your Trip with UTA](#) webpage first. It shares schedules/maps for the bus and rail, how to pay, and tips for riding. You can also download the **Transit app** through your preferred app store to purchase tickets, see schedules and get tips for riding the transit system. Look for this logo in your app store:



## AUTOMOBILES

## BIKES & SCOOTERS



Mountain biker? Street biker? Salt Lake City is ready for you!

For the mountain bikers, there are [great trails for both beginners and experienced bikers](#) to explore. Salt Lake City also offers great urban tours as well. Here is a little [more information about different guided and self-guided tours](#) and how to make the best choice for you.

[Canyon Sports](#) offers road, mountain and hybrid bikes and associated equipment (helmets, etc.) for daily fees. While they accept walk-ins, they do request reservations. Canyon Sports is a 10 minute walk or 3 minute drive from The Little America Hotel.

[GREENBike](#) is Utah's only non-profit bikeshare. GREENBike is dedicated to supporting community wellness and transportation affordability while improving air quality and overall connectivity and engagement for both residents and visitors. When you purchase a Single Pass for \$3.50 for 60 minutes, you can rent a classic or electric bike to get around Salt Lake City. [Additional passes](#) are also available. [Here is a map of all the locations around Salt Lake City](#). There are three locations within two blocks of The Little America and Grand America Hotels. The map conveniently shares what bikes are available and what spaces are left for parking in real time. Downloading the BCycle app provides you access to GREENBike as well as many other urban bikes offered in other cities.



Electric scooters are readily available throughout the city as well. Fun to ride, you are still subject to the rules of the road and good safety measures within the Salt Lake City area. Birds and Limes are the go to for SLC scooters!
